

PABC Standing Committee Volunteer Form

Be a part of innovative changes, and help shape the future of your association and physiotherapy in BC! Committee volunteers are vital in ensuring the decisions PABC makes are representative of our diverse membership base. The Standing Committees meet regularly, one to four times per year, and these supportive groups are always looking for new enthused members.

PABC Standing Committees:

- The Business Affairs Committee (BAC) is a group of private practice physios that advise on private practice
 matters like; what resources to put on the website, how to help members navigate WSBC and ICBC matters,
 etc. Meetings are four times per year, usually in-person, and one via conference call.
- The **Public Practice Advisory Committee (PPAC)** is a group of public practice physios that advise on public practice matters like; advocating for the benefits of working in public practice. Meetings take place four times per year, in-person and via conference call.
- The **Rural and Remote Advisory Committee (R&R)** is a group of physios that practice in rural and remote settings. They advise on issues and opportunities related to rural and remote practice. Meetings take place four times per year usually by conference call and one in-person.
- The **Professional Development Advisory Committee (PDAC)** is a group of physios that advise on the education courses that PABC runs. They work closely with our Knowledge Service Team: Terri McKellar Knowledge Services Manager, Nathan Hers Education Manager, and Alison Hoens Knowledge Broker. Meetings take place once or twice a year in-person with most work being done over email.
- The Forum Planning Committee is a group of physiotherapists (and other volunteers) that help to plan the
 Forum and especially the speakers. The group consists of representatives from PABC, the College, and UBC
 on the Committee. The meetings take place three or four times per year via conference call and in-person
 meetings.
- The **PABC Awards Committee** is a group of volunteers that collect nominations for PABC awards and determines the winners of these awards. Meetings take place one to two times per year and usually by conference call with emails in between.
