ICBC Now Accepting Interim Registrant Applications for Direct-Billing Privileges

Starting March 15, 2021, ICBC will begin accepting applications from interim registrants for direct-billing privileges. This will enable physical therapists awaiting final examinations to both treat ICBC customers and direct bill ICBC for approved services. To obtain billing privileges, interim registrants must be added to an existing vendor number for the billing of services provided under supervision. To apply for billing privileges, interim registrants must:

- Provide all necessary application documentation to BIProviderApp@icbc.com, as found on [Vendor number](#) and outlined below:
 - Signed and completed [CL174G - Vendor application form](#) - add/remove practitioner
 - Practitioner documents:
 - Driver's licence, BCID or BC Services card
 - Proof of registration in good standing with the College of Physical Therapists of BC, including registration number (i.e., copy of your College practice permit)
- Provide proof of at least the minimum requirement of professional liability insurance as required by the College of Physical Therapists

Please note, interim registrants who change practice locations must complete and submit a revised [CL174G - Vendor application form](#) to BIProviderApp@icbc.com.

Interim registrants must immediately notify ICBC of any change in registration status, including failure to pass an examination that results in the removal of their interim registrant status or a change to full registrant status.

All applications will be processed in the order in which they are received. Current wait times from receipt of application to vendor number confirmation is approximately 10 weeks when all required documentation is provided at the time of application submission. Any significant increase in volumes may delay current processing times.

Physical therapists, interim and full, with an ICBC vendor number must continue to maintain registration in good standing with the College of Physical Therapists of BC.
