Anatomical Intramuscular Stimulation AN-IMS 1

AN-IMS is an intensive 4-day hands-on course created for practitioners who have not taken any IMS/Dry needling courses previously or are new to this application of dry needling. This includes those who have previous acupuncture training. AN-IMS instructs participants in the neuropathic clinical reasoning framework, which allows the practitioner to be safe and effective across patient populations. In this course participants will investigate the anatomical and physiological mechanisms of neuropathic theory as well as gain significant practical experience applying IMS/dry needling to the whole body.

AN-IMS 1 is taught by instructors with extensive experience in IMS/dry-needling as well as anatomy, physiology and manual therapy. All of our instructors also have experience teaching in or are currently teaching at Canadian post-secondary Physiotherapy programs.

ANIMS-1 is the equivalent of parts 1 and 2 of other dry needling programs. The entire body is covered in this comprehensive 4 day course.
